

2018 Hidden Valley Lake Boat Driver Exam

All residents applying for a boat sticker must take this exam and answer **all** questions correctly prior to receiving their stickers. All answers to the questions below are disclosed on the enclosed Lake Rules.

THE PERSON TAKING THE EXAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR INFORMING ALL PERSONS OPERATING HIS/HER BOAT OF HVL RULES.

MULTIPLE CHOICE: *Circle the letter of the correct answer*

- Watercraft picking up a downed skier, tuber or wake boarder must immediately slow down to a no-wake idle speed and:
 - wait for them to swim to the boat
 - turn to the right for pick up
 - turn to the left for pick up
 - cut in front of another boat to pick them up
- Water craft may **NOT** perform the following while operating at high-speed:
 - travel clockwise around the lake
 - perform "S" turns
 - perform "figure 8" turns
 - all of the above
- The normal period of time for the main lake to be in open or "green light" status is:
 - Between 9:00 a.m. and sunset
 - 24 hours a day
 - Between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
 - Between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- When on the lake, **all** watercraft must be equipped with US Coast Guard approved PFD's totaling:
 - One (1) for each seat on the boat
 - two (2) times the number of persons on board
 - five (5)
 - amount equal to or greater than the number of people on board
- You may not register the following watercraft:
 - Kayak
 - Jet ski
 - Pontoon boat
 - Power boat

- Only an HVL POA member may register his/her water craft.

- A **YELLOW** light indicates that skiing and wakeboarding is allowed, but use caution.

- Boat trailers may be stored in the emergency spillway area overnight.

- All powered watercraft must travel in a clockwise direction within the high-speed zone on the main lake except when picking up a downed skier, tuber, wake boarder or a person from a flotation device.

- The use of installed boat devices and/or boat operations that cause the creation of damaging or dangerous wake are prohibited on the HVL Main Lake.
