

Yesterday afternoon, Governor Holcomb gave an update on the COVID-19 (coronavirus) situation in Indiana and issued new directives to limit its spread. Hidden Valley Lake (HVL) will comply with all the state's guidance as well as modify some activities on our own.

Complying with the State of Indiana Directives:

Willie's:

Steve Van Wassenhove, Willie's owner, has provided us with the following statement:



“Beginning on Tuesday, March 17 and continuing until the governor lifts the restriction (currently projected to be March 31), you will not be able to dine-in at Willie's. Willie's will be open for carryout orders only. **Orders can be phoned to (812) 537-0512.** Phone ordering is preferred as it will minimize wait time and contact with other individuals.

Carryout times will be 11:00 am until 8:00 pm and the full menu will be available. We will offer curbside service for those who are unable to come into the building. For curbside business, we ask that you pay with a credit card when you phone in your order.
