

2023 Hidden Valley Lake Boat Driver Exam

All residents applying for a boat sticker must take this exam and answer **all** questions correctly prior to receiving their stickers. All answers to the questions below are disclosed on the enclosed Lake Rules.

THE PERSON TAKING THE EXAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR INFORMING ALL PERSONS OPERATING HIS/HER BOAT OF HVL RULES.

MULTIPLE CHOICE: *Circle the letter of the correct answer.*

- To register your watercraft, you must:
 - be a HVL POA member in good standing
 - pay the appropriate watercraft registration fees
 - provide a certificate showing current watercraft liability insurance
 - all of the above
- This watercraft requires registration and a sticker:
 - Kayak
 - Sailboat
 - Inflatable Paddleboard
 - All of the above
- Watercraft picking up a downed skier, tuber or wake boarder must immediately slow down to a no-wake idle speed and:
 - turn to the left for pick up
 - turn to the right for pick up
 - wait for them to swim to the boat
 - cut in front of another boat to pick them up
- When on the lake, **all** watercrafts must be equipped with US Coast Guard approved PFD's totaling:
 - amount equal to or greater than the number of people
 - One (1) for each seat on the boat
 - two (2) times the number of persons on board
 - Five (5)
- Watercraft may **NOT** perform the following while operating at high-speed:
 - travel clockwise around the lake
 - perform "S" turns
 - perform "figure 8" turns
 - all of the above

- A watercraft may pull or tow only one person at a time in a high-speed zone, except on a tube where you can pull 2 people.

- The use of installed boat devices and/or boat operations that cause the creation of damaging or dangerous wake are prohibited on the HVL Main Lake.

- All watercraft are required to have lights equipped and illuminated when operating in the lake between sunset and sunrise.
